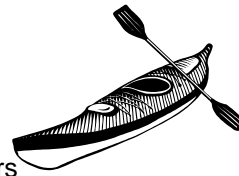
### SUNSET KAYAK PADDLE

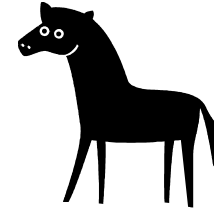
### AN AFTERNOON AT THE IMAX

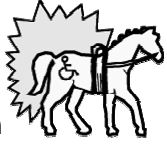
### HORSEBACK RIDING ADVENTURE

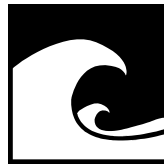

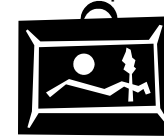


## YOUNG ARTISTS' STUDIO ART SHOW & OPENING RECEPTION
