SAILING

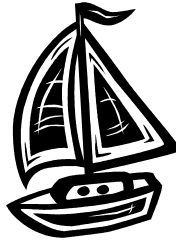
Thursdays, Aug. 11th, Sept. 8th, and Oct. 13th
