

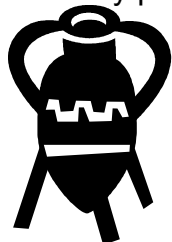
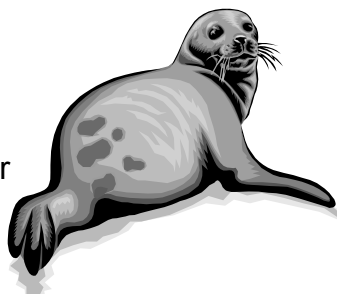
ELEPHANT SEAL EXCURSIONS AT AÑO NUEVO

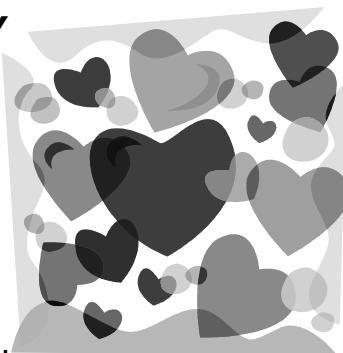
VALENTINE'S DAY DANCE PARTY WITH LIVE BAND

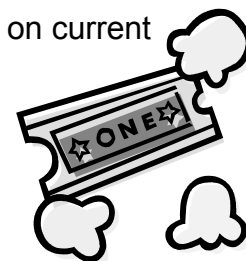
MOVIE OF THE MONTH NIGHTS

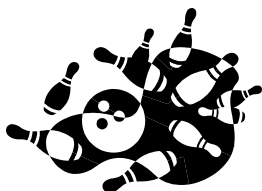
3rd ANNUAL DAY IN THE SKY

Time: 10:30am -12:30pm **Cost:** \$3/game (includes shoe rental)

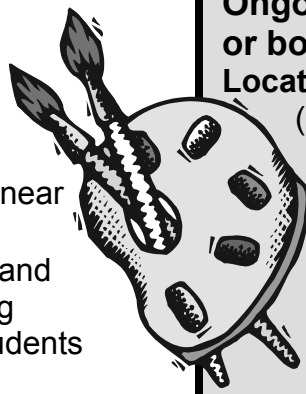
Come out of the cold, and join us for a fun filled afternoon at the lanes! This activity continues to be one of our most popular; come ready to have fun and practice your technique.
