Hope you had a happy holiday season, and let's have an adventurous new year!

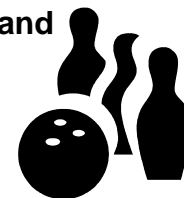

BOWLING BY THE BOARDWALK Sundays, January 15th and 29th, and February 12th and 26th

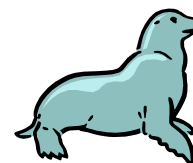

ELEPHANT SEAL HIKES Saturdays, February 18th & 25th

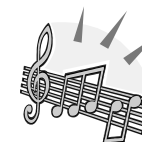
Location— Ano Nuevo State Park

CERAMIC PAINTING

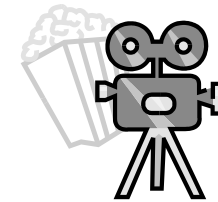
